

**South Bucks District Council's *Energy Efficiency Grant*:
an insulation grant to help householders who are 60+
and not receiving benefits to meet the cost of loft
insulation and cavity wall insulation**

South Bucks District Council is helping householders who own their home and are 60+ and not in receipt of benefits to insulate their homes! The information below is taken from South Bucks District Council's website:

This is for energy efficiency measures for owner occupiers of pensionable age.

Eligible works include:

- o Loft insulation (where existing insulation is less than 100mm thick)
- o Cavity wall insulation
- o Hot water cylinder/tanks/pipe insulation
- o Draught stripping

Who can apply?

Owner occupiers of pensionable age.

How much is the grant?

The grant provides 50% of the cost of the works up to a maximum grant of £500, i.e. the home owner will be required to make a 50% contribution to the cost of the works.

Are there any other conditions?

Limit of one application per property over a three year period.

The works must be completed within four months of grant approval.
