Minutes of meeting held on Monday 14<sup>th</sup> March 2011, in tennis club room at Sports Pavilion, Iver Heath Recreation Ground. (Drafted by F.Charlton/Tennis, prior to circulation by IPC)

**1 Apologies for Absence:** Mrs P.Leech/IPC, Mrs E.Hemsley/Bowls

**2 Minutes of Previous Meeting (20/09/2010)** were approved/signed

**3** Noted that following should be removed from circulation list:

**4 Premises Inspection of whole building:** not undertaken. R. Peters assured meeting that: football accommodation was clean; new ballcock fitting had restored water supply in tennis toilet cubicles; faulty pump in boiler room would be repaired; S. Vigurs confirmed that youth room floor is mopped on Tues. and Thurs. nights.

**5 Matters raised by Chairman:** Female **bowls** player numbers continue to increase and the club had requested use of football changing rooms for summer matches, which was agreed by the meeting. Bowls club to let IPC know dates when they wish to use the Pavilion so that Ray / Sally / Football can be informed.

**6 Matters raised by Clubs: Football** reported that the Saturday Iver Heath Rovers team had withdrawn from this season's League as the opposition was too strong, but would definitely join a lower Division next season. The Sunday team continues to play its fixtures. Summer training will take place - away from the match pitch - at 7pm on Tuesdays and Thursdays, from first week of July to mid-Sept. Enquiry received from Thames Valley Juniors.

**Youth** reported reduced numbers of older attendees on Tues. nights; Thursdays for 11s to 15s popular; outings arranged; discipline procedures being tried; R. Peters may attend a Thurs. session. S. Vigurs said that use of the youth pool table could be made available to tennis club, in view of removal of its table from youth room.

**Bowls** had asked what the response might be to solar panels on their roof.

**Tennis** reported that its annual Maintenance Day had just been held, with many outdoor and indoor jobs completed. No progress on equipment storage building project. Club Coaches to be advised to call Sally Vigurs' number, rather than the Police, when youth-fighting or racist remarks disturb on-court activities - for possible identification of culprits.

**7 General Discussion:** Car parking a problem for sports clubs on many occasions, but Ray Peters is concerned about more use of field parking. Clubs to be encouraged to let each other know of big events on their seasonal calendars and park sensibly.
