MINUTES

73. **To receive apologies for absence** from Mrs Leech, Mr Wilson, Mrs Watkins, Mr Bradford
74. **Disclosure of interest in items on the agenda** - None
75. **Resolve to sign the Minutes of the Highways and Partnership meeting** held on 21st January 2009 (previously circulated). *Sylvia Lidgate arrived at 8.05 during the next item.*
76. **Goods Vehicle Operator's Licence (a)** – Dromenagh Farm, Seven Hills Road, Iver Heath - noted
Goods Vehicle Operator's Licence (b) – West Drayton Depot, Thorney Mill Road, West Drayton – noted. The clerk advised that notice had been withdrawn following the advert for Dromenagh Farm. There is a need for vigilance as they may apply again.
77. **Zebra crossing A412** – Chris Schwier has been advised that a warning sign is needed for the new crossing.
78. **Swallow Street/Love Lane, Anti-social parking** – Sgt Clayton George commences 6th April 2009 requested he contact Ruth Vigor-Hedderly re parking issues in Swallow Street/ Whitehouse Way and Norwood Lane/Love Lane. Could more substantial sticks be used? Love Green Lane - highway disintegrated by the pond and the road needs to be reinstated.
79. **Buckinghamshire County Council (A412 Uxbridge Road Central Reservation, Iver Heath) (Prohibition of Motor Vehicles) Order 2009** – noted
80. **M25 Junction 16-18 Construction work for widening of the motorway** – noted.
81. **Traffic Regulation Amendment Order 200** – applies to St Margaret's Church Iver Heath only. Noted.
82. **Proposal by Buckinghamshire County Council to make an order prohibiting motor vehicles in Hollow Hill Lane** – the golf club owner is willing to pay for the work. It was suggested that an earth bund (similar to that in Hollybush Lane) be used for a trial period.
83. **County Council/Thames Valley Police Community Speedwatch Scheme** – Richings Park Residents Association may loan their equipment to Denham Parish Council if asked.
84. **Buckinghamshire County Council delegated budget 2009/2010 Highways** – agreed hard standing for North Park and Richings Way but request funds for Colne Orchard to move kerb.
85. **Budget Monitoring to end of February 2009** – figures were accepted and approved. Resolved to approach Bucks County Council for additional funding for one extra day per week for Devolved Highways person. Resolved to purchase flashing light for the Highways van (Renault Kangoo).
86. **Letter from resident of Iver Lane** – letter to resident accepting comments but directing the resident to contact Hillingdon.
87. **Report from Chris Schwier on condition of roads in Iver** – noted.
88. **To approve more funding for TSID** – Resolved to purchase two TSID's, two batteries, a portable platform for the Devolved Highways Person and insurance for the above. Risk assessment to be undertaken for Wood Lane near the Crooked Billet in the 40 mph zone and near the Red Lion in the 40 mph zone. Also Langley Park Road in the 40 mph zone towards Langley and near the Church in Iver Lane
89. **Richings Park Residents Association request the Council to consider the purchase of a moveable TSID** – covered in above item.
90. **Chairman's Report**– the two members of the public present have their vision obscured when turning onto High Street from their car park behind the baker's. They were advised to provide the clerk with the registration numbers of the offending vehicles and to write to the landlord of the property opposite requesting permission for a convex mirror to be fitted to the wall advising they have the backing of the Council. The Chairman invited discussion in respect of parking and yellow lines. Resolved to request white painted bus signage on the road at the bus stop opposite the Village Hall in Iver High Street

Possibility of a left turn only sign for the junction of Chequers Orchard was discussed. Clerk to ask PCSO Dave Castle whether (on a late shift) he would mind taking a councillor around with him to view parking problem areas and to ticket vehicles or advise why he cannot ticket.
