- 1 **Nominations for Chairman** – Mrs Vigor-Hedderly (proposed by Mrs Watkins and seconded by Mrs Roberts). Mrs Gibson (proposed by Mrs Lidgate and seconded by Mr Wilson). Votes for Mrs Vigor-Hedderly - five
- 2 **Resolved** to elect Mrs Gibson as vice chairman for the ensuing year (proposed by Mrs Roberts and seconded by Mrs Leech. All in favour.
- 3 **Resolved to receive apologies for absence** from Mr Oxley.
- 4 **Disclosure of interest in items on the agenda** – there were none.
- 5 **Resolved to sign the Minutes of the Highways and Partnership meeting** held on 31st March 2010 (previously circulated).
- 6 **Goods Vehicle Operator Licences** – noted that TNT Post UK Ltd of Globeside Business Park. Fieldhouse Lane Marlow SL7 1HY requested a licence for 34 goods vehicles and 28 trailers to use Unit 1 Ridgeway Industrial Estate Thorney Road South Iver SL7 9HX as an operating centre.
- 7 **Total number of vehicles licensed at Thorney Business Park and Court Lane** – question sent to the LAF for the meeting on 30th June 2010.
- 8 **Temporary prohibition of through traffic order 2010** - noted
- 9 **Street light trial in Iver** – resolved to contact Mr J Bingley of Zumtobel Lighting Ltd to request an LED street light trial in Iver.
- 10 **Parking outside Iver Junior School** – Mrs Leech to enquire of Mr C Collis if he preferred to apply for “Zig Zag “school keep clear” or the hatched keep clear yellow box suggested by Mr M Averill and if this is for the main entrance and or the car park entrance.
- 11 **Wood Lane (Crooked Billet end) dips in road** – noted.
- 12 **Delegated budget for 2010/2011** – ascertain from Ms Z Ford if the Swallow Street and verge opposite Love Green Lane have been listed on the programme of works and exact location for the bollards.
- 13 **Winter Maintenance question** – received 7th June 2010, copies passed to Councillors for comment.
- 14 **Bus stop cage, Iver High Street opposite the Village Hall** – check on progress of consultation, request a copy is sent to the Parish Council for comment, copy Mr M Averill in.
- 15 **Thames Valley Probation service gang** – noted.
- 16 **Highways Report from Nick Fisher** – the Chairman extended her appreciation to Mr Fisher for the concise report. a) Bollards for Swallow Street, Whitehouse Way and Swallowdale i) ask County to fund the work that Nick would undertake, labour and materials. ii) Investigate using the Probation Service Gang for the work. iii) Explore use of rocks or wood blocks to prevent parking on verges. iv) Sacrifice the wide verges from Whitehouse Way to Swallowdale for parking. Ask Nick to arrange a meeting with Ms Z Ford to discuss the best method for obtaining the desired result.
- 17 **Budget report** – the Committee requested a further £300.00 for the Devolved Highway work budget from the Devolved Salary Budget..
- 18 **Chairman’s Report**– Chairman thanked Pat Robert’s for her support over the past years. Mrs Vigor-Hedderly has been promoted to lead cabinet spokesperson for transport. Request from Mr Adlam that the Thornbridge Road pavement decals be cleared off excess cement to reveal the designs.
