**MINUTES**

57. **Resolved to receive apologies for absence** from Mr Oxley, Mrs Lidgate & Mr Wilson.
58. **Disclosure of interest in items on the agenda** – none.
59. **Resolved to sign the Minutes of the Highways and Partnership meeting** held on 10th November 2010 (previously circulated).
60. **Parking in Iver High Street by the clock tower** – Received survey summary of 41 respondents. Noted mixed views and quality of arguments both for and against parking controls. Resolved to refer to Police road traffic offence concerns raised and to County Council the whole area of parking control measures and appropriate specific issues raised by respondents.
61. **Goods Vehicle Operator Licences** –
  - i) Received from Cllr Gibson a summary of VOSA data concerning numbers of HGVs and trailers licensed to operate in this area. Noted the difficulty of obtaining accurate and reliable information in an environment of constant change. Resolved to seek a meeting with County Council to try to find a way forward with their support to restrict and control HGV movements through the residential areas of the parish.
62. **Copy agenda & minutes from Cappagh Liaison Meetings** – Received, and noted that County Council was actively pursuing compliance. Next liaison meeting scheduled for Friday 18 February.
63. **Copy correspondence with SBDC on HGV numbers and movements** - Received and noted.
64. **Trial Sunday bus service** – Received oral report that the Sunday 58 Bus appears to be self-financing, that it is welcomed and used by people of all ages within the community, and that an application had that day been sent to the Traffic Commissioner for its continuance in service. Resolved to seek further sponsorship from public and commercial entities, and to seek to extend the service to include Richings Park and George Green.
65. **Iver Junior School parking outside main gate** – Noted that white lining will be delayed by works at the school.
66. **TSID data analysis** – Received report & noted. Resolved to take up with County Council the question of suitable sites in Wood Lane and Church Road.
67. **Road Safety Checks** – Noted.
68. **Street Lighting** – Received with grateful thanks Cllr Oxley's comprehensive report and noted his recommendations. Resolved to seek a way to adopt LED replacement lighting at the earliest cost-effective opportunity.
69. **Budget monitoring** – received and noted budget to 12th January 2011. Resolved that any budget surplus in the current year should be allocated to LED replacement lighting and that a suitable location be identified in consultation with the parish lighting contractor.
70. **Chairman's Report**– Discussed concerns regarding overgrown footpaths, cycleways, and road signs obscured by traffic grime. Resolved to bring matters to attention of Highways Dept, suggesting where appropriate Community PayBack Team involvement.
