62. **Resolved to receive apologies for absence** from Mr Adlam.
63. **Disclosure of interest in items on the agenda** – None.
64. **Resolve to sign the Minutes of the Highways and Partnership meeting** held on 19<sup>th</sup> November 2008 (previously circulated)
65. **Goods Vehicle Operator's Licence** – Thorney Business Prk, Thorney Lane North, Iver – noted.
66. **Goods Vehicle Operator's Licence** - Summerleaze Ltd, Denham Quarry, Denham Road, Iver - noted

67. **Make the Commitment** – information pack from County Hall passed to Mr Oxley for discussion with Richings Park Residents. Mrs Leech would inform Mrs Gill from the NAG
68. **Consultation on the Hillingdon Draft Climate Change Strategy 2009 /2012** – resolved to make no comment.
69. **Thornbridge Road Shops Improvements to Parking** – Julian Wilson reported on a meeting he had with officers from the District and County Councils and the contractor. The island is being parked on and he suggested a double stepped kerb. Some double yellow lines were also suggested and a 1 hour time limit on parking in the diagonal bays. Moving an area of tactile surfacing outside Copse wood would prevent the parking which currently blocks a resident's drive. Bollards to be put where the tactile paving was. All were agreed by the officers and the physical changes will be done straight away. BCC will consult on the parking restrictions. The Committee welcomed the alterations.
70. **Chairman's Report**– the flooding issues in Billet Lane have been resolved by Highways sending a mechanical digger to clear the grips and slips. Dirkin contractors working on the A412 had one weeks extension for their work, one lane has been closed excessively when no work was being done, Chris Schwier from Highways was asked to investigate. There was a serious accident in the High Street, Iver and a fatal accident in Bangors Road South. Neither of these incidents were due to road conditions. The TSID should be operational in Richings Park. However the lamppost is too wide for the sign to be fitted and it was moved to Iver High Street for two weeks. Richings Park Residents association to meet with Highways to resolve.
71. **Sustainable Development** – the document was passed to Mr Bradford to report to the Planning Committee on either the 29<sup>th</sup> January 2009 or 19<sup>th</sup> February 2009. The consultation period ends on 26<sup>th</sup> February 2009.
72. **Street lighting in Stonecroft Avenue** – BLE Contractors advise that the bulb has been replaced frequently. Local residents will be asked if there appears to have been any vandalism or vehicle hitting the lamppost. If there are no issues it was decided to change the lamp head. If the cause may be due to vandalism it was decided to request the police use the street camera to ascertain the exact cause.
