MINUTES

1. Apologies for absence were received from Jeanette Watkins, Claire Mowat, Simon Hill and John Illenden
2. The minutes of the meeting held on 16th April 2007 were signed as a correct record.
3. Matter for information only – a dead tree had to be removed on the A412 boundary last week. Clerk is visiting the area with a tree surgeon to survey the other trees on the site. Fallen larch reported at last meeting has been carefully removed. Clerk yet to visit with the tree surgeon due to the weather. Noted.
4. Grass cutting delayed by the weather. Barry Harding has been in touch with Jan Buck about the ragwort. Noted.
5. Simon Hill had made a written report giving details of his butterfly walk, the condition of the grass and some new plants now growing, including ox-eye daisies, yellow rattle, hairy tare, brown knapweed, yarrow and bladder campion. Also seen are English bluebells and Roesel's bush crickets. John Illenden had suggested several possible future plantings, and asked about 50% financing for these. Finance to be referred to Amenities Committee.
6. FOIH were concerned that the pathway, known as The Carriageway, was becoming very narrow and asked if it could be widened. The fence bordering Muddy Alley has a lot of new graffiti and it was asked if this could be painted out. Not much trouble with motorbikes this year.
