7 Apologies for Absence: Mr T.Gould/Football, Mrs P.Roberts/IPC
8 Minutes of Previous Meeting (11th June 2007) were approved and signed.

9 Premises Inspection:

Footballers' accommodation: hand basin tap not working in changing room, Home team door hinges need repair, store cupboard and entrance doors need refitting

10 Clerk's Report: The Chairman went through agenda items:

a) Chris Campbell and Chris Sproules comprised a new maintenance team (to include field and pitch care) who started work today (17.09.07.) and will meet representatives of clubs as soon as possible. Larger outdoor lock-up and front ladies' side changing room to be used by them for storage/changing/rest and they will remove mound of stone from field shortly.

b) Green path not successful so hedge cut back and tarmac repairs to be made.

c) Although Amenities Committee had approved bollards to be installed by tennis club contractors to protect boundary fencing, Bison to be approached again for donated kerb provision.

d) Noted that field boundary hedges are to be cut back on police advice

e) Noted that tennis shutters have been serviced but F.Charlton, although aware of grease, could not confirm definite improvement

11 Matters Raised by Chairman:

In response to her enquiry about the football pitch, R.Gould confirmed as good the condition, line-marking and cutting. Mrs Lidgate said that the new maintenance team would utilise the IPC's own white-lining equipment.

(a) Football: Mr Gould reported that Iver Minors had requested use of the pitch for a match on 22nd Sept.

(b) Tennis: Mrs Charlton reported on successful public opening of red mini tennis court/kidzone, thanked IPC for co-operation and contribution to project and commended the enormous paperwork input to Bucks LTA from club Chairman, Mark Watson.
