MINUTES

22. Apologies for absence were received from Derek Adlam and Julian Wilson
23. The minutes of the meeting held on 21st January 2008 were signed as a correct record.
24. Information from the Clerk noted.
25. Project Pinewood is causing concern among residents. FOIH asked Mrs Lidgate to write a letter explaining that until the planning application is presented there is no information to give, and Mrs Brain and Mrs Buck undertook to hand deliver this.
26. IDCA report: Mr Hill reported that there had been fires started in the bomb hole and that the Fields had been harrowed. He had noticed some dead field mice. The trees planted by the Scouts were doing well and the daffodils were out. Mrs Brain agreed to give Flowerland some photographs of the daffodils with a message of thanks for their donation.
27. FOIH report: Work on the main ditch is finished. Brambles have been cleared behind Pinewood Green and around the field maple trees planted by FOIH. Some residents of Pinewood Green and Ashford Road are dumping vegetation over their fences. Agreed that a letter should be mailed to all those residents whose gardens back onto the Fields reminding them that this is illegal dumping. The Scouts held an Easter egg hunt on Easter Sunday. The sign by the stream has been cleaned of graffiti. The recent dispersal order in Swallow Street seems to have caused some youths to move to the Fields, and there has been a lot of litter. The paths are due to be cut in soon.
