

**A meeting of the IVER RECREATION GROUND GROUP and
ALL ALLOTMENT HOLDERS GROUP was held on Wednesday 20th July 2011 at 7 pm in the
Meeting Room at Iver Parish council Offices. 63 Chequers Orchard, Iver SL0 9NJ**

Minutes (taken by Mrs Moffat the Clerk)

Present: Mr Woolley (Chairman), Dr Matthews, Mrs Leech Mr Mounteney, Mr Francis (Saxon Court), Mr Hyland (Saxon Court) and Mr Harris (Scouts).

1. Mr Woolley was elected as Chairman and Mrs Leech as Vice-Chairman for the ensuing year.
2. **Apologies:** were received from Mr Oxley, Brian and Jackie Griffiths and Mr Lewis.
3. **Minutes** from last meeting held on 9th March 2011 were approved and signed as a correct record.
4. **The Clerk reported** that all the funding is in place for the new pavilion and the Council has agreed for the building work to proceed. This should start in 6 to 8 weeks and completed within 6 months.
5. **To resolve** that the Advisory Group will continue to meet for the foreseeable future and to remove Mr Copas from the circulation list.
6. **Other Matters to be raised by**
 - i. Residents from Saxon Court – A person was reported to the police riding a motorbike on the recreation ground a couple of months ago. The registration number was known but there has been no feedback from the police. Concern about the barrier being left open when the Community Payback Team use the pavilion on Tuesdays. A query was raised about use of the ‘old’ pavilion once the new one is built. The Clerk replied that it will hopefully be converted in to a storage shed to be used by the groundstaff. Other concerns raised were about the traffic on the High Street/Langley Park Road:- (a) Double yellow lines needed opposite Widcroft Road as very dangerous with the extra long lorries, (b) Possibility of changing the speed limit to 20 mph but it was explained that this is not possible and must remain at 30mph, (c) Some lorries are un-netted. Dr Matthews explained that the Parish Council is taking up this concern with VOSA and the Police and lastly (d) a question was asked about recycling bins for residents at Saxon Court being stored in the car park. Mrs Leech explained that this was not allowed due to the possibility of vandalism. The matter should be taken up with South Bucks District Council to see if a special arrangement could be made to deal with this.
 - ii. Allotment Holders – Iver – No representatives were present.
 - iii. Allotment Holders – Iver Heath – No representatives were present.
 - iv. Scouts - Mr Harris reported that the Scouts are keen to become involved in the community. The Clerk reported that the building works should not affect the scout hut but there will be roped off areas at the entrance to allow for movement of construction vehicles and equipment.
 - v. Delaford Colts – Mr Mountenay raised the point that storage containers should be installed at the rear of the new building as soon as the first footings have been laid whilst there is access.
 - vi. BMX Club – No representative present although the Parish Council has been trying to arrange a meeting with the Club but has had no response.
7. **Any other matter to be raised by Iver Parish Councillors** - Mrs Leech informed members that building work will be commencing at the front of Iver Junior School during the summer holidays until the end of the Autumn term which will cause more traffic congestion in the area. A new kitchen is being built to provide hot food for schools in the area.
