

**A meeting of the IVER RECREATION GROUND GROUP and  
ALL ALLOTMENT HOLDERS GROUP was held on Wednesday 22<sup>nd</sup> September 2010 at 7 pm  
in the Committee Room at the Parish Council Offices, 63 Chequers Orchard, Iver.**

**Minutes** (taken by Ms Collins the Clerk)

**Present:** Mrs P Leech (Chairman) IPC, Mr Lidgate IPC, Mrs Watkins IPC, Mr Mounteney Delaford Colts, Brian Griffiths (Saxon Court), Justin Lane (Buzz) BMX club, Mr Hammond and Mr Brain. (both of Iver Heath Allotments)

9. **Apologies:** were received from, Mr Wilson, Mr Clark, Mr Lewis, Mrs Gill, Mr Luckhurst, Sally Vigurs
10. **Minutes** from last meeting (30<sup>th</sup> June 2010) were approved and signed as a correct record.
11. **Matters to be raised by the Chairman or Clerk.** There were none.
12. **Other Matters** to be raised by
  - a. **Allotment Holders – Iver** – no reps.
  - b. **Allotment Holders – Iver Heath** – Mr Hammond asked whether the start of the year for letting allotments could be the end of September rather than April/May. The clerk explained that invoices are sent out in April because that is the start of the financial year but that plots are let all through the year now as they become available because there is a waiting list for both sites. The admin assistant keeps a constant eye on plots that are not being cultivated and with warning to the holder takes them back for re-letting as soon as possible. Mr Lidgate gave his phone number to the allotment holders for manure supplies. The clerk said that there was more land that could be made into allotments but the cost would be high because of the equipment needed to clear the land and that access is difficult now for large equipment. Mr Lidgate suggested keeping pigs on a patch of land to clear it. Mrs Leech said the Amenities Committee would consider this.
  - c. **Scouts** – no rep
  - d. **Delaford Colts** – Mr Mounteney said that the dogs mess is bad as usual and the grass is too long but that he understands this is because the tractor requires repair and that it will be done next week.
  - e. **BMX Club** – Mr Lane explained that the club has had its first meeting but has now closed for the winter. There may be the occasional Saturday morning meeting. He would want use of the toilets in the changing rooms and it was agreed that some procedure to safeguard the children and the changing rooms needs to be put in place and notified to the Council and then the key will be given. Eg a CRB checked person needs to hold the key during club meetings (as the building cannot be left unlocked when the club is being held so far from the toilets and young people could be at risk going on their own). It was noted that football is also on Saturday mornings and so there could potentially be parking issues although most BMX club members come by bike.
  - f. **Residents** – Mrs Leech reported a complaint from Mrs Gill about the nettles under benches. Rev Griffiths asked again about the sign for Saxon Court and it was agreed that size and position needs to be notified to the Amenities Committee for their agreement to place a sign on PC land.
13. **New Pavilion** – Mrs Leech reported that the Council is still trying to go for a new pavilion but that the Football Foundation has reduced the amount of money it can give to the project. Therefore, alternative funding is being sourced (SITA, BAA). She asked that Delaford Colts provide the paperwork showing rejections from potential funders and also a letter of support for the project from the Club itself. Mr Mounteney said he would provide this.
14. Any other matter to be raised by Iver Parish Councillors – there were none.
