- 12. Apologies were received from:- Mrs Vigor-Hedderly, Mrs Roberts & Mrs Gibson.**
Therefore in the absence of the chairman and vice chairman Mr Wilson was elected to chair the meeting.
- 13. Disclosure of interest in items on the agenda - None**
- 14. RESOLVED to sign the Minutes of the meeting held on 14th May 2007 & 23rd May 2007**
- 15. Clerks Report:-**
 - (a) Photos taken by residents of Dutton Way of HGV parking have been sent to the Traffic Commissioner and the Police via the NAG. - **NOTED**
 - (b) The clerk showed the committee a list of highways works to be done in the Iver area from the minutes of the South Bucks Joint Local Committee. This was discussed and it was suggested that the new bus shelter for Bangors Road North was sited on the Stag and Hounds side of the road near St. Davids Close. Clerk to find out more information about the Pinewood Road new access signalisation.
- 16. RECEIVED letter from resident regarding traffic on Bangors Road North and A412 – copy sent to BCC Highways asking for response to resident and copy to us – Clerk to send copy to Cllr Mowat and ask her to raise the issues of HGV's and traffic at the next Nag meeting.**
- 17. Thornbridge Road Shops line marking –following a meeting with Chris Schwier it was confirmed that the potholes and road surfacing would be made good and the line marking carried out. Mr Wilson will follow up with Chris Schwier and will also enquire about highways issues at Sevenhills Road.**
- 18. A412 Pedestrian Crossing – a meeting held on 29th May revealed that Anne James from Highways holds the budget that could provide money towards a new crossing. There are numerous types of crossing available. £70k would cover a big crossing with lights and £20k would cover a different type of crossing. A working party is trying to raise funds.**
