The Parish Council are updating the Parish Plan and a questionnaire is available on the website. This is your chance to influence the way in which all the local councils undertake their duties and activities. You can also get the questionnaire from the Parish office at the police station in Iver High Street.

Development work continues next to Iver Recreation ground but this should soon finish and as a result an improved car park will be provided for the recreation ground. The new playground came from funds received by the Parish Council as a result of arrangements with the developers to have access to the land for development.

The allotments in Iver and Iver Heath are being very well used and there is now a waiting list on both sites.

A group of Richings Park residents have appealed to the Parish Council and County Council to reduce the speeding of vehicle on Richings Way and North Park; it is hoped to get Vehicle Activated Speed indicators for those roads and more police enforcement against speeders.

The much needed improvements to the parking area adjacent to the Thornbridge Road shops are expected to be in place this year. This will provide better parking and a more attractive environment around the shops and has resulted from pressure from the Parish Council and local residents.

Have you walked the footpath into Black Park yet? This arose from a Parish council initiative which was supported by Pinewood Studios which was prepared to reopen this pathway which allows residents to walk to the park and avoid driving and paying for parking.

Unfortunately this year's planned Iver Carnival had to be cancelled due to the three venues used being waterlogged. It is now intended to hold the carnival in the early summer next year.

On 6th December the Parish Christmas lights will be switched on at Iver Village Hall at 2.30pm. There will be stalls, refreshments, children's rides, carol singing and of course Father Christmas to turn on the lights. All are welcome.

an incident of vandalism or anti-social behaviour to report it. For crimes in progress the number is still 999.

Project Pinewood – the Parish Council called a meeting at the end of September, which 200 people attended, to discuss Project Pinewood. The Parish Council advised residents that they would oppose the planning application as the development is on Green Belt land.
