### **Facilities owned or maintained by the Parish Council include:**

**Burial Ground off Iver Lane** belongs to the Parish Council but is administered by St Peter's Church. For all information contact 01753 654843 Mike James, the church administrator.

**St Peter's Churchyards** are closed and are maintained by the Parish Council.

**Iver Heath Recreation Ground** is owned by the National Playing Fields Association but is leased to the Parish Council on a long lease. The Parish Council manage the area, which comprises football pitch, children's playground, teenage shelter, tennis club, bowls club, multi use games area and car parking.

**Iver Recreation Ground** is owned by the Parish Council and has a small changing room, football pitches, children's playground, multi use games area and teenage shelter. Car parking.

The Parish Council looks after all the **seats** in the parish. About 30 in total various locations.

### **The Parish Council owns and maintains all the bus shelters (9) in the parish as follows;**

A brick one on Slough Road (near Swallow Street junction)

A metal one on Church Road (by the Parkway)

A metal one on Bangors Road North (near Stag and Hounds)

A soft wood one on Bangors Road North (opposite the Heathway)

A soft wood one on Swallow Street (near Norwood lane junction)

2 hard wood ones on Bangors Road North (one near the Stag and Hounds and one near the Black Horse)

1 hard wood one on Swallow Street (near junction with Coopers Row)

1 hard wood one on the High Street (outside junior school)

The Parish Council owns all **dog bins** in the Parish but the policy is only to put them on land owned by the Parish Council. The bins are emptied by the District Council.

The Parish Council only owns and empties **the litter bins** within the 2 recreation grounds.
