

IVER PARISH COUNCIL NEWSLETTER (November 2006)

The Iver Carnival was held on 16th September and thousands of people attended. There was a great parade from Iver Lane through the High Street, up Love Lane and into Evreham with dozens of floats and walking groups entered. . The cup for the Best Float was won by Richings Players and the Best Junior Float cup was won by Iver Junior School (adjudicated by Julian Wilson). There were some magnificent arena displays at Evreham, many stalls and live music from three bands. The evening ended with fireworks.

There was a youth project held at both our recreation grounds during the summer months which involved painting walls. The project was carried out in partnership with South Bucks District Council and Thames Valley Partnership. Artists assisted young people to produce some wonderful representations of points of interest from the local area. If you haven't seen the results already it is well worth a visit to the recreation grounds off Church Road, Iver Heath and the High Street, Iver.

A new area of Iver Heath Fields has been opened up and any thoughts from residents about how this can be used should be sent to the parish council office.

The allotments in both Iver and Iver Heath are being very well used. Many new allotments have been let this year and there is a definite interest in producing fresh vegetables and fruits for home consumption. There are still a few plots available and at only £12 a year are good value for money and think of the exercise you will be getting. There is a very friendly atmosphere and people help each other. One of the allotment holders at Iver Heath site has agreed to be the contact for plot holders. Iver Heath sports pavilion has had an internal facelift.

The parish council is requesting funding for more bus shelters in Bangors Road North and in Bathurst Walk near the resident's garden. There is also a project to provide better access to St. Leonard's mound to facilitate its use by residents.

The parish council, together with Delaford Colts Football Club, is seeking to raise funds to build a new pavilion in Iver Recreation Ground with changing rooms and storage for grounds maintenance equipment.

The long awaited pathway into Black Park will be provided by Pinewood Studios this year. This will mean that there is walking access from Iver Heath into Black Park, saving residents from paying parking fees. Watch this space!

You will no doubt have seen our 2 Police Community Support Officers walking the streets. The parish now has 2 police constables and 2 police community support officers. These along with a sergeant and a police constable who covers Wexham and Stoke Poges are based at Iver Police Station. To contact them please ring 0845 8505505.
